

Education Facilitator – part time

- Are you interested in ensuring that young people and vulnerable adults have access to the education and support they need and want so that they can make their own informed choices around relationships, sex and sexual health and understand the importance of Consent?
- Does the opportunity to work part time, the choice to work the hours that suit you and the choice to work from home or the office appeal to you?
- Do you like the idea of joining a friendly, supportive, fun but professional team?

If you answered ‘yes’ to the above, then this could be the job for you!

- Hourly rate is £12.75.
- Hours of Work: **15 to 21 hours per week (you choose!), to be worked over 3 or 4 days - between Monday and Thursday.**
- This is an 18-month fixed term contract for term time only OR a 12-month fixed term contract including term time hours.
- Full training on our projects will be given to the successful person.

Our short-term educational projects support vulnerable young people and adults to better understand the importance of healthy relationships and sex and how to keep themselves and others safe. Participants attend up to seven one-hour sessions and our sessions are designed so that they can be delivered to either individuals or groups. We work in a range of provisions across Cambridgeshire e.g. schools, colleges, residential projects, and our sessions can also be delivered online.
