

WORRIED about a child or young person?

Any child or young person can be abused anywhere at any time. Children and young people with disabilities are especially vulnerable. Children can be abused by anyone – adults or other children.

How to report suspected or actual abuse of a child or young person to Cambridgeshire County Council or Emergency Services:

Important contact telephone numbers and addresses

- **Emergency: If a child is in immediate danger or left alone you should contact the Police on 999**
- **During office hours (8am-8pm Mon to Fri) you can contact: Children's Social Care Services at Cambridgeshire Direct on 0345 045 5203**
- **If you urgently need help outside these hours you can contact Cambridgeshire Children and Young People's Services on 01733 234724**
- **You can also speak to the: NSPCC on 0800 800500**
